

Dr. Michiel Streijger

Michiel Streijger studied Greek and Latin at Radboud University Nijmegen. In 2008 he received his PhD in Philosophy with a doctoral dissertation consisting of a critical edition with study of John Buridan's commentary on *De generatione et corruptione* of Aristotle. As a postdoctoral scholar he worked for the Richard Rufus of Cornwall Project at Stanford University (with Prof. Rega Wood).

Since 2014 he has been working at the Bavarian Academy of Sciences and Humanities in Munich, preparing a critical edition of book 2 of Robert Cowton's commentary on the *Sentences* of Peter Lombard (in two volumes).

Michiel is attached to the Center for the History of Philosophy and Science at Radboud University Nijmegen as an Associate Researcher. Together with Prof. Paul Bakker he is preparing the third and final volume of Buridan's *Physics* commentary (so far two volumes have been published).
